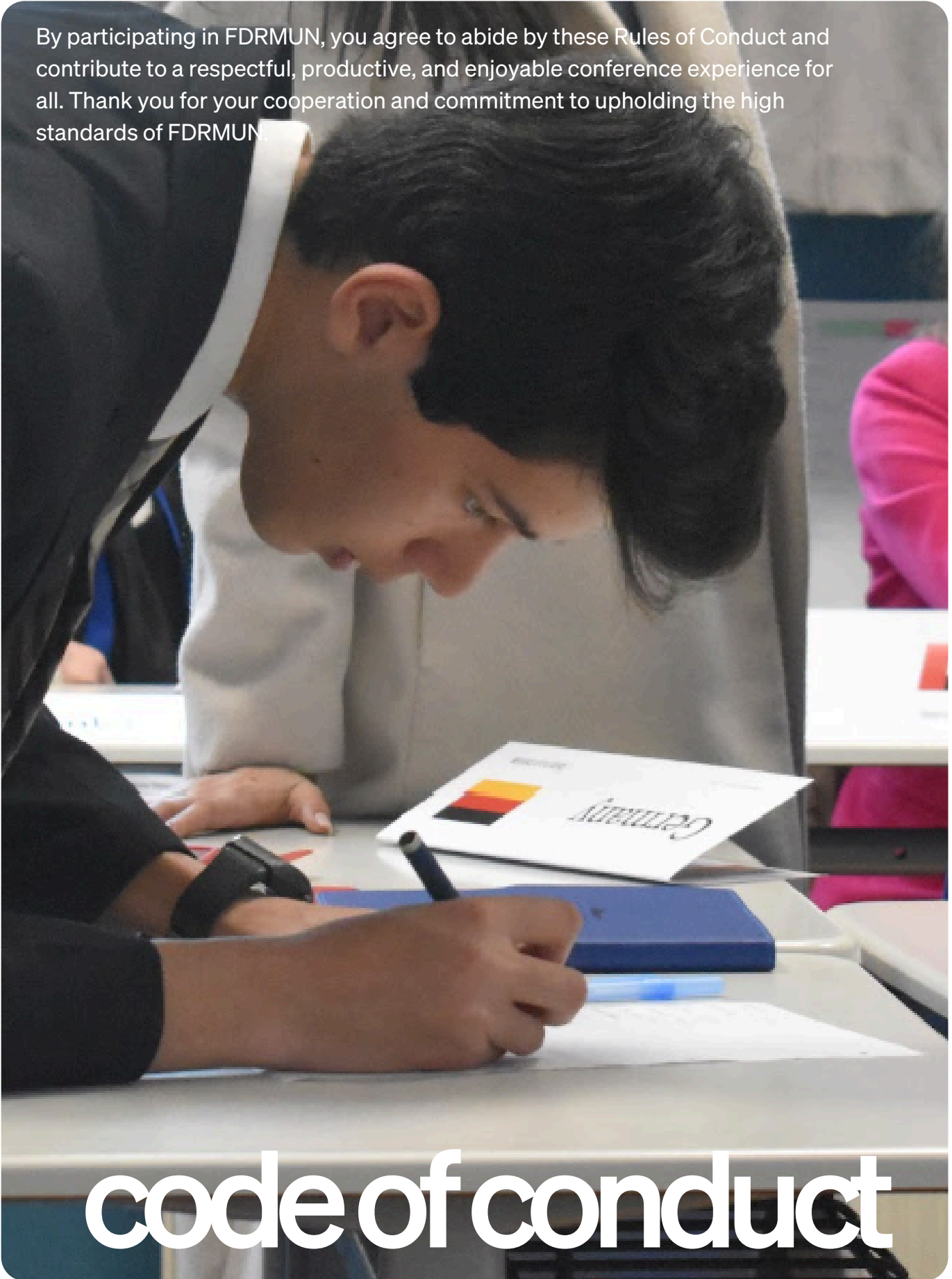

General Conduct

1. Respect and Professionalism

- Treat all participants, including delegates, chairs, advisors, and staff, with the utmost respect and courtesy.
- Refrain from using offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate language or behavior.

2. Punctuality and Attendance

- Attend all scheduled sessions, committee meetings, and events on time.
- Notify your chair or conference staff in advance if you will be late or absent from any session.

3. Dress Code

- Adhere to a professional dress code, which includes business attire for all formal sessions and events.
- Casual attire is permitted only during designated informal events or social gatherings.

Committee Conduct

4. Preparation and Participation

- Come prepared with research and position papers relevant to your assigned country and committee topics.
- Actively participate in discussions, debates, and negotiations within your committee.

5. Yielding and Speaking

- Follow the committee's procedural rules for speaking, yielding, and making points or motions.
- Respect the authority of the chair and abide by their instructions and rulings.

6. Collaboration and Diplomacy

- Work collaboratively with other delegates to draft resolutions and develop solutions.
- Engage in diplomatic negotiations and strive for consensus-building.

Technology and Communication

7. Use of Technology

- Use electronic devices, such as laptops and tablets, solely for conference-related activities during sessions.
- Ensure that all electronic communications and social media interactions are professional and appropriate.

8. Respect for Conference Property

- Handle all conference materials, equipment, and facilities with care and respect.
- Report any damage or technical issues to conference staff immediately.
